

NOTE: Councilor Beaudoin objected to the Non-Public Session, but still participated.

Proposed Land Swap with Sig Sauer

Scala provided an update on the Milton Road/Salmon Falls Road intersection project. The project is part of the City and State's MOU with Sig Sauer for the construction of its factory near the intersection and part of the City's PILOT Agreement with Sig Sauer.

Since the signing of the MOU and PILOT, Sig Sauer purchased property located in the middle of Milton Road, ie. 125 Milton Road (the former Trinkets & Treasures). The existence of 125 Milton Road made the City's plan for a roundabout on Milton Road less desirable. If 125 Milton Road is removed, the City would redesign the roundabout.

Sig Sauer also purchased more abutting properties in anticipation of business expanding if it received the US Army's contract for its new rifle and squad automatic weapon. Sig Sauer did, in fact, receive said contract from the US Army and now will be greatly expanding its operations.

Director Nourse addressed the Council on the efficacy of the removal of 125 Milton Road and how it is best for the City to build the roundabout where 125 Milton Road currently exists. Nourse reiterated the safety benefits of a roundabout as opposed to other solutions for the intersection.

Councilor Hamman asked how the plan affects the two business across the street from Sig Sauer. Nourse said the effect is unknown as the City is still in the conceptual phase, but does plan to meet with those owners.

Councilor Beaudoin asked the estimated cost of the roundabout. Nourse said right now it would be about \$2.7 million. Beaudoin said it looks like a wash because Sig Sauer will be paying about \$2.4 million in increased taxes during the project. Nourse said that Sig Sauer will also be providing \$250k per year for two year toward this project.

Scala and Nourse proposed that the City swap its remaining abutting properties on Amarosa Drive in exchange for 125 Milton Road.
