Conditional Use Base Criteria

1) Allowed Use or Departure.

The use of a warehouse is permitted by a conditional use permit.

2) Intent of Chapter.

This proposal is for a flooring warehouse and showroom that is a compatible use in this neighborhood. This new businesses activity will be contained indoors and will have a minimal traffic impact.

3) Intent of Master Plan.

This proposal is consistent with the master plan, due to the master plan requiring a symbiotic relationship between businesses and abutting residence.

4) Compatibility.

Design: The existing structure will remain, be updated and renovated which will increase the value of the surrounding properties.

Use: The use of this facility will help with local small business and sense of community in the surrounding neighborhood.

5) Streetscape.

Currently there is little to no vegetation on site. The new owners are open to consider minor landscape improvements.

6) Resources.

This use and renovation of the property will improve natural, scenic, historic, and/or cultural resources as listed in the base criteria.

7) Public Facilities.

This facility will put no significant impact on the city's public resources to include the city's public water, sewer and roads.
