### V. Opening Discussion/Comment

#### A. Public Comment

### VI. Approval of minutes

A. November 5, 2012 – Regular Meeting

## VII. Continued Applications / Extensions

Mr. Campbell explained to the board the applicant is requesting a six month extension as they are waiting for a lot merger.

A motion was made by <u>Mr. Peters</u> and seconded by <u>Mr. Kozinski</u> to approve the extension. Motion carries.

## VIII. Discussion of CIP

Mr. Sylvain explained to the board this has to be back to the City Manager in letter form by December 30<sup>th</sup>.

Mr. Sylvain asks if the board would like the department heads in to go over the CIP.

The board agrees to look over the book and decide at its next meeting which departments they will want to speak with.

#### IX. Other Business

## A. Review of October surety

<u>Mr. Campbell</u> let the board know he met with Ms. Young today, he stated she is getting into the files so she can get up to speed.

Mr. Peters questioned the older projects on the surety list.

<u>Mr. Sylvain</u> asked <u>Mr. Campbell</u> if it would be possible to have the old projects taken off the list for the December retreat.

Mr. Peters pointed out that Rochester Toyota is still on the surety list.

<u>Mr. Campbell</u> stated the Planning office is still waiting for the As-Builts.

The board reviewed the inspection list and noted there are projects being done and inspections are still not being completed.

<u>Mr. Sylvain</u> pointed out that Waste Management has been completed and there hasn't been an inspection done yet.

<u>Mr. Sylvain</u> questions whether or not the Department of Public Works has a form in place for a developer to submit.

Mr. Martineau asked for a chart of the procedures Public Works follows.

<u>Mr. Peters</u> remind the board that Ms. Young and Mr. Nourse are not the scapegoats, but everyone needs to be on the same page.

<u>Mr. Gray</u> suggested that the board draft a letter to the City Manager stating they have been trying for months to get results on this issue. He suggested they try again at the retreat, but if things don't get corrected the City Manager and City Council take action.

Mr. Sylvain suggested the City Manager and some of the Council members attend the retreat.

Mr. Sullivan questions the recording process through the Planning Department.

Mr. Campbell stated the office gets the figures from Ms. Clark at Public Works.

<u>Mr. Walker</u> and <u>Mr. Sullivan</u> stated the understanding was the Planning Board was to see all the inspections because they believe inspections are not being completed.

**Discussion ensues** 

The board clarifies to <u>Mr. Campbell</u> exactly what they want to see on the inspection reports from the Department of Public Works.

<u>Mr. Sylvain</u> asked <u>Mr. Campbell</u> to make it clear to Mr. Nourse and Ms. Young the board is not out to headhunt. The system is broke and the board needs their help to fix it.

A motion was made by <u>Mr. Gray</u> and seconded by <u>Mr. Jaffin</u> to adjourn at 7:45pm. The motion carried unanimously.
