The following information is provided to support discussion of items on the Agenda.

Project Funding/Priorities

In July, a request was made to have an Agenda Item for the August PWC to discuss CIP projects and funding. Attached are spreadsheets that document unexpended funds or active projects for 4 categories: Highway, Water, Sewer and Buildings & Grounds.

DPW and Finance staff are meeting on Wednesday, August 19, to review all CIP projects. The objective is to estimate project schedules and expected durations to determine their impacts on the City budget and bonding. It is expected the results will be presented at a future PWC or City Council Meeting.

City Hall Annex

DPW requests approval to proceed with final design services with Oak Point Associates (OPA). We may have a detailed proposal for review at the PWC Meeting and if so, will ask the architect to attend the PWC Meeting. We are meeting with OPA's project architect and president on Monday, August 17, to discuss our project in detail, including scope and design services.

OPA was initially selected in April 2014 to conduct a Facilities Assessment of the Annex. The City solicited architectural firms on a qualifications-based process and OPA was chosen. There is no commitment that we retain OPA for final design services, but based on their qualifications and current knowledge of the Annex Project, we recommend proceeding with OPA.

In reviewing the Facilities Assessment in detail, I have confidence that the budget amount of \$3,734,000 will be sufficient. The project is relatively straight-forward. My only technical concern is retrofitting the interior with steel moment frames for structural reinforcement and seismic stability. This will be discussed with OPA, along with schedule and project delivery

options – such as whether design-build might be a desirable option as opposed to traditional design-bid-construct.

The overall project budget needs to include construction inspection and administration services and a design-build process might be financially competitive, and even desirable. With design-build, we could strategically select qualified firms for exterior appearance work, such as re-pointing and replacing the masonry brickwork. That could ensure we retain the most qualified and experienced contractor. With a design-bid-construct process you are committed to the lowest bidder. A blended approach might work as well. We could selectively choose design-build for exterior aesthetic reasons, and conventionally bid the interior renovations, structural and mechanical work.

Strafford Square

We are engaging additional engineering services to hopefully eliminate any problems with Walnut Street being fully integrated into the proposed roundabout.

A roundabout design specialist has submitted a preliminary proposal for additional engineering review. It needs to go to the lead design firm, Fay, Spofford & Thorndike for inclusion and submittal as part of the overall project. The intent is to conduct the following:

- Sketch Walnut Street tying into the current roundabout layout as a fourth leg and identify potential remedies or fatal flaws to solve non-conformance issues.
- Sketch a potential 4-leg solution for at least the inbound leg with a larger roundabout to resolve non-conformance roundabout operational issues. Focus of this alternative will be what additional properties/ROW would be needed.

As previously discussed, DPW had concerns with the design as proposed. Due to space constraints within available rights-of-way, inbound traffic on Walnut Street would only be allowed to turn right onto Washington Street. Additionally, Twombly Street would need to be designated as a Truck Route, necessitating an intersection upgrade at North Main Street.

Reviewing prior meeting minutes, it appeared that we were getting a less than optimal solution. There was note to the effect "*that this is the best that can be done given the constraints of the area*".

Stillwater Circle

The City's obligation for landscaping was discussed at the July PWC Meeting. An Amount of \$10,360 was approved by the City Council back on May 6, 2014.

Pending approval by the PWC, we would like to solicit at least 3 landscaping firms to provide proposals on how they could best spend the allotted \$10,360 in providing vegetation and improvements. The price amount would be fixed at \$10,360 and DPW staff would select the proposal that seemed to provide best value in terms of appearance and long-term maintenance.

Reviewing history of the issue:

- March 11, 2014 Finance Committee Meeting Residents of Stillwater Circle requested consideration of recreation related improvements. DPW didn't feel funds were sufficient for any type of playing fields. Directive was to get price quotes.
- April 17, 2014 Public Works Committee Prices for recreation fields were too high. After discussion, motion was approved 4-1 to recommend to the City Council that

they approve \$10,360 for landscaping at the entrance and put the area on the City's mowing list.

• May 6, 2014 City Council Meeting – Motion carried by majority voice vote to approve \$10,360 for landscaping and to have the area placed on the City's mowing schedule.

Wakefield Street

The Wakefield Street reconstruction project sits on hold at the 30% design stage, per prior year CIP budgeting. We request approval to proceed with final design. The proposed project area runs from Union Street up to Chestnut Hill Road. Work would include street reconstruction, sidewalks, water main replacement, drainage, and sewer upgrades.

The 2016 CIP includes funding as follows:

- Highway \$2,250,000
- Water \$1,600,000
- Sewer \$350,000

Final engineering services would come from the above budgeted amounts. Construction likely couldn't commence until the spring/summer of 2016, at the earliest. Construction could be held pending the outcome of prioritizing all of the CIP projects.

The engineering firm working on this project is Tighe & Bond.

Woodman/Myrtle Streets

We request approval to begin design on this project which is an extension, or companion project, to the ongoing Catherine, Sheridan & Glen Project.

A total amount of \$300,000 was included in the 2016 CIP, presumably for survey and engineering design. The \$300,000 is based on \$100,000 each from Highway, Water and Sewer.

We recommend proceeding with the engineering firm of Wright-Pierce. They designed the Catherine, Sheridan & Glen Project. We are pleased with their work on that project, and this next phase ties closely with the prior work, especially with a focus on the water main work. We hope to implement water main upgrades such that we might abandon the cross-country water main that runs across the Fairgrounds.

Areas for consideration in the overall project include Myrtle, Woodman, DavyAnn Locke, Beaudion, Ela, Congress and possibly Academy.

Please note that there is no funding for actual construction in the FY 2016 Budget, only design services. This project could be prioritized when discussing the status of all other pending CIP items.

Project Updates

Chesley Hill Road – final pavement is scheduled to be placed beginning Monday, August 17.

Water Storage Tank Rehabilitation - scheduled to start in earnest the week of August 24th, following the isolation and draining of Chesley Hill on August 19th. Improvements include installation of active mixers at Chesley Hill and Salmon Falls; full surface cleaning and painting of Chesley Hill Tank; roof repairs on Salmon Falls Reservoir; foundation repairs at

Rochester Hill; and general electrical/telemetry upgrades and site/security improvements at all three tanks.

Milton Road Sewer Extension EDA Project – final resolution of easement issues is pending. Depending on status of easements, it might be appropriate to enter into Non-Public Session to discuss specifics. By the time of the PWC, things should be in the hands of the City Attorney to resolve any legal issues.

We expect that bidding will still occur this fall, we will proceed ASAP pending final review and approval by EDA. But the window is rapidly closing in order to see any actual construction work commence this fall.

Catherine St./Sheridan Ave./Knight St. – construction remains ongoing. Everything appears to remain on schedule. Base pavement should be placed by late fall. Work has been prioritized in front of William Allen School such that the Granite Street pavement is expected to be completed by Friday, August 21. Final pavement and cleanup with occur spring/early summer 2016.

Franklin Street – the consulting firm, Brown & Caldwell, got verbal permission from NHDES for the culvert design and modifications. The project will go before the Conservation Commission on Wednesday, August 26. A formal environmental permit will be submitted by the end of August. An Alteration of Terrain permit is required from NHDES. Additionally, the sewer upgrade work requires approval from the NHDES Wastewater Bureau. Pending approval by NHDES, we will work to get this project out to bidding as soon as possible.

Granite Ridge – the onsite inspector provided an update that the electrical and plumbing work is proceeding at the pump station. The pouring of the concrete floors is tentatively scheduled for next week (week of August 17). Utility work within Primary Drive is near complete. Drainage work is proceeding along the remainder of Frontage Road (Marketplace Boulevard) this week. Utility work within Secondary Drive is tentatively scheduled for next week.

Colonial Pines – Brown & Caldwell is also working on this project. We requested an update and received the following:

- 1. Colonial Pines- Based on initial feedback from NHDES, we will proceed with modifying the drain culvert and lower its profile so the new sewer can be routed above the culvert. We need to finalize the design of the sewer alignment and complete a hydraulic analysis to size new culverts and then complete the wetlands application to NHDES. We should be able to complete the permit and submit the application in a month or two. We will also need Rochester Con Com sign off prior to submittal to NHDES.
- 2. Colonial Pines- NHDOT- NHDOT has reviewed preliminary information and the sewer crossing would be acceptable provided we comply with their manual requirements and we locate any manholes outside DOT's "right of way". Our alignment at the crossing needs to shift to the north and will require a property easement. Wetlands delineation, survey and borings in this area are needed to complete the final design and prepare an Encroachment Permit.

Pavement Repair – The Highway Department O&M Budget included \$65,000 for our personnel to tackle various pavement repair projects. The crew recently completed repairs on Charles Street, Sullivan Farm Road, Haven Hill Road, Sampson Road and

Whitehouse Road. The objective was to make sufficient repairs in order to minimize winter snow removal problems.

Bicycle Lanes – DPW staff met with Mike Provost and Jen Marsh to discuss the viability of "sharrows" – which is a modification of traditional bike lanes. Sharrows implement pavement markings within existing travel lanes, as opposed to creating designated bike lanes, in order to encourage integration of bicycles into the travel lanes. Mike and Jen are researching the use of sharrows in other communities.

Other items to note

We are working to address various HVAC related CIP or O&M projects in the 2016 Budget. I've been working with an HVAC engineer to make sure we make optimal selections on new equipment in regards to efficiencies and optimization. Individual projects are proposed at Central Fire, the Community Center, City Hall and the Library. Hope to wrap up most of these before the cold weather sets in.

DPW Facility – would like to keep this on hold pending a detailed review of options. The results of the <u>DPW Facility Study</u> were presented at the May PWC Meeting by Weston & Sampson (W&S). Their total project costs were estimated at \$24 million for a new facility to be constructed on Pickering Road. It seems prudent to thoroughly consider all upgrade options at our existing location before committing to a new facility at an off-site location.

From the <u>DPW Facility Study</u>, they recommended a new facility should include 11,700 square feet of administrative and staff support space, 18,000 square feet of maintenance and shop space, and 24,000 feet of heated vehicle storage space, including a truck washing facility, and an 8,000 square foot small-vehicle storage canopy. Recommended site amenities include a 3,000 ton-capacity Salt Shed, a 7,000 square foot open canopy for Salt Spreader Storage, a fuel facility designed for all-city use, bulk storage areas (e.g. salt, sand, loam, gravel, road grindings, etc.), and a public salt pick-up area.

Their cost estimates include escalations for construction in the future, but they also include \$3 million for site development (new site) and \$3.6 million for soft costs and contingencies. Although our current footprint is very tight and limited, we have adequate existing facilities such as fuel system, salt storage, salt spreader storage, etc. Our main problems are related to lack of heated vehicle storage, wash bay and maintenance area.

We might be able to develop a phased plan for a sequence of upgrades at our existing site. More research is warranted.
