Bidders are to monitor website for addendums, and postings of all bid questions and answers. All bid proposals must be on the bid proposal forms supplied and the proposal forms must be fully completed when submitted.

The scope of the work for the base bid includes but is not limited to:

Chesley Hill Tank

Removal of existing coating and painting of a 1.0 million gallon welded steel water storage tank, preparation of a health and safety plan for removal of lead paint, and installation of an active mixing system.

Salmon Falls Reservoir

Removal of existing coating and painting of the roof of a 2.0 million gallon welded steel water storage tank and installation of an active mixing system.

Rochester Hill Tank

Repair of the concrete foundation.

The scope of work for BID ALTERNATE A includes, but is not limited to furnishing a portable chlorine injection unit and all associated piping and equipment at the Chesley Hill Tank and Salmon Falls Reservoir.

1. Completion time for the project will be calculated days from the date specified in in the "Notice to Proceed" as follows:

130 calendar days for substantial completion.

160 calendar days for final completion.

Liquidated damages will be in the amount of $\frac{1,000}{1,000}$ for each calendar day of delay from the date established for substantial completion, and $\frac{1,000}{1,000}$ for each

- calendar day of delay from the date established for final completion.
- 2. Each General Bid shall be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of 5% of the Total Bid Price.
- 3. The successful Bidder must furnish 100% Performance and Payment Bonds and will be required to execute the Contract Agreement within 10 days following notification of thee acceptance of his Bid.
- 4. No Bidder may withdraw a Bid within 60 days after the actual date of opening thereof.
