Question from Muni Code:**

C. Vendor must have a minimum of two existing Government  
clients in New Hampshire

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**Rochester, NH Bid #16-24, for codification services**  
**Questions from General Code:**

**1.) Do you have the exact page count of your code? If so, what is the page count?**

*City of Rochester: The City of Rochester is currently updating several Chapters of the General Ordinance. Until this work is finalized the exact number cannot be given; however, there are approximately 526 pages to our full General Ordinance, which includes one page for each of our 22 Reserved Chapters. Additionally, the City of Rochester's Chapter 42 Zoning Ordinance contains 230 pages.*

**2.) Is your code up-to-date?**

*City of Rochester: Yes, the City Clerk must keep the most recent updates on the City's Website in a PDF format as follows: [click here](#)*

**a.) What is the last legislation included in this Code?**

*City of Rochester: The latest legislation posted to our website is Chapter 63 Rights and Duties of Pedestrians. Prior to posting any of our Amendments online, the Codes and Ordinance Committee reviews the final text of the document. The City Council is sending (4) four Amendments to the February 4, 2016, Codes and Ordinance Committee for final review.*

**3.) Is Zoning to be included in this RFP?**

*City of Rochester: Yes, this is our largest Chapter of our General Ordinance and likely the most referenced: Chapter 42 Zoning Ordinance*

**4.) Are all Vendors together in this pre-proposal conference?**

*City of Rochester: Yes, the City has requested one mandatory pre-proposal meeting [January 21, 2016], which is open for any/all interested vendors to meet at the same time and location.*
