Pest Control

6-202.15 Outer Openings, Protected.

- (A) Except as specified in $\P\P$ (B), (C), and (E) and under \P (D) of this section, outer openings of a FOOD ESTABLISHMENT shall be protected against the entry of insects and rodents by:
 - (1) Filling or closing holes and other gaps along floors, walls, and ceilings;
 - (2) Closed, tight-fitting windows; and
 - (3) Solid, self-closing, tight-fitting doors.

Tips for preventing pest invasion

- (1) 16 mesh to 25.4 mm (16 mesh to 1 inch) screens;
- (2) Properly designed and installed air curtains to control flying insects
- (3) Control vegetation surrounding your building; rocks around the perimeter are helpful
- (4) Avoid leaving out bird seed
- (5) Inspect, control, and contain food within the establishment
- (6) Control refuse and ensure dumpster is rodent proof
- (7) Ensure floors are clean
