

## AGENDA ROCHESTER CONSERVATION COMMISSION MEETING OF MARCH 24, 2021

Good Evening, as Chairperson of the Conservation Commission I am declaring that an emergency exists and I am invoking the provisions of RSA 91-A:2, III (b).
