- I. **Call to Order**. The meeting was called to order at 7:03 p.m. by Ms. Meulenbroek.
- II. Approval of minutes for November 8, 2017.

The minutes from November 8, 2017 were approved by <u>Ms. Jones</u> and seconded by <u>Ms. Dibble.</u>

III. **Federal Savings Bank– Portsmouth Sign Company**, 17 Wakefield Street, Certificate of Approval for a wall sign. Case# HDC 120 – 406 – DTC – 18.

The applicant Portsmouth Sign Company presented the redesigned Federal Saving wall sign. The sign will be the same size as the previously approved sign but the location of the sign on the building will be adjusted. The roof sign will be removed with the eagle on the side.
