Application for Lot Line Revision TLR-III South Area – Rochester Neck Road Realignment Turnkey Recycling and Environmental Enterprise Rochester, New Hampshire

Dear Mr. Campbell:

Enclosed is a Lot Line Revision Application to revise the lot lines of Parcels 267-2 and 267-3. This application is submitted to satisfy General and Subsequent Condition #3 of the December 11, 2017 Notice of Decision for Site Plan for TLR-III Refuse Disposal Facility - South Area (Case #267/268 - 2&3/2&2-1-RI/A - 17). The approval addressed, in part, the realignment of a  $\frac{3}{4}$ -mile long portion of Rochester Neck Road (RNR), which is bounded by Parcels 267-2 and 267-3, both owned by Waste Management of New Hampshire, Inc. (WMNH).

As presented in the approved Site Plan, the RNR realignment involves the following land transfers:

- The land within the right of way (ROW) of the portion of the existing RNR being replaced will be transferred from the City to Parcel 267-2;
- The land within the new, realigned RNR ROW will be transferred from Parcel 267-3 to the City; and
- The land north of the realigned RNR ROW and south of the existing RNR ROW will be transferred from Parcel 267-3 to Parcel 267-2.

Because the enclosed Lot Line Revision Application is associated with an approved Site Plan approval, the application only contains the specific information related to the lot line revision and does not repeat the information contained in the approved Site Plan application.

As required by the City, WMNH respectfully submits four (4) copies of the application, which consists of the application form, supporting information, and two checks – one for the application fee (\$175) and one for the abutter notices (\$20.25).

Please know that WMNH anticipates that construction and City acceptance of the RNR realignment will be complete in October 2020. We understand that approval of the requested Lot Line Revision will be conditioned on the City's acceptance of the realigned RNR and that the deeds associated with the Lot Line Revision will be recorded with the City and Strafford County following written receipt of the City's acceptance of the realigned RNR.
