
Bulky Waste

You may place your bulky items on the curb the 2nd full week of each month or you may bring to the Turnkey Drop-off Center. Please see the Collection Calendar on the inside panel for Bulky Waste pickup weeks.



Turnkey Drop-off Center

90 Rochester Neck Rd, Rochester NH 03839 Hours: Monday, Wednesday and Friday 8:00 a.m. -3:00 p.m. and Saturday 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.

Items Accepted at Turnkey Drop-off Center:

- Commingled glass, plastic, and metal
- Cardboard, newspaper, junk mail
- Scrap metal, drain all liquids
- Computers, including hard drives and monitors
- Televisions
- Tires with or without rims, 8 per year per house
- Leaf and yard waste, no large stumps
- Solid waste (must be delivered to the drop-off in maximum 30 gallon bags.
 City-approved stickers to affix to bags must be purchased at the City's Revenue Office for \$1.75 Each.)
- Bulky items (furniture, carpet, etc.)
- Construction debris, small amounts
- Demolition debris, small amounts

Household Hazardous Waste Day

On **May 5, 2018** you may bring up to 10 gallons of the following to the Household Hazardous Waste day site:

House and Garden Products – weed killer and fertilizer, no-pest strips, bug spray, oven cleaners, batteries, pool chemicals, etc.

Garage Products - car wax, polish, fuel additives, antifreeze, brake fluid, transmission fluid, etc.

Workshop/painting products - Oil or enamel-based paint stains and finishes, paint strippers and removers, etc.

Items NOT accepted – latex paint, motor oil, tires, computers, zinc, carbon and alkaline batteries, recyclable batteries, car batteries & propane tanks.

Frequently asked questions

I'm planning to clean out the garage and have a lot of refuse to get rid of right away. Where should I dispose it?

As a Rochester resident, you can bring trash outside of your normal day collection to the Turnkey Drop-off Center. Or the Bagster® Bag could be another solution. You can find the Bagster® Bag at any Home Depot, Lowes, or other local hardware stores for \$29.95. Once filled, call the Waste Management number on the package to get the Bagster® Bag collected. Schedule

Trash and recycling are collected weekly. All materials should be placed at the curb by 7:00 a.m. on your collection day. Please see the 2017-2018 Calendar on an adjacent panel that indicates special collection dates like yard waste and bulky waste.

Trash

All regular household refuse must be bagged and placed in your 64-gallon green cart only for collection. Materials may not protrude from the cart and the lid must securely close.

Note: Do NOT place recyclables in the SOLID green cart.

The following items will NOT be accepted in the trash cart:

- Dirt. sod. concrete or rock
- Construction/demolition debris
- Household hazardous waste
- Hot ashes or flammable materials such as oil, gas or paint

If you have any normal household garbage that is not recyclable and does not fit into your cart, you can place the excess garbage in 30 gallon bags and affix a sticker on each bag. Stickers can be purchased at the Tax Office for \$1.75 each. Bags must be brought to the Turnkey Drop-off Center for disposal NOT to be placed curbside.

Care and use of the cart:

- Always keep the lid closed to keep rain, snow and animals out.
- Clean the cart periodically.
- Since automated waste collection requires clearance for the vehicle's lifting mechanism, any cars parked at the curb should be at least 5 feet from the trash cart.

Keep space between objects and carts.

Objects and cart are too close together.

Place wheels of cart toward house.

The placement of the cart is very important as the collection vehicle's lifting arm requires clearance of at least 3 feet on both sides of the cart and 12 feet overhead. Carts should be no more than 3 feet away from the road's edge, with the arrow facing the road and handles facing the house.

Carts should remain on the property at all times and are the property of the City of Rochester. Please do not take the containers with you if you move. All carts should be labeled with your property address. Should your cart require repair, please call Waste Management at (800) 972-4545.

Recycling

Recycling not only conserves precious natural resources, it also helps to reduce costs by decreasing the amount of materials that end up in the landfill.

- Only materials inside your recycling containers will be collected. Large cardboard boxes must be broken down and placed inside the bin.
- Recycling containers should be placed curbside every week on the same day as your trash collection.
- · Paper and cardboard can now be commingled in the same bin with glass, plastic and metal containers..
- See a list of all acceptable recycling materials on the adjacent panel.
