Questions:

1. Are the directional dimensions available for each Play ground/Site to match the 4100s.f and 4500 s.f ?

2. For those unable to make the Site Visit on 9/19/19- can the questions and/or information gathered from that meeting be provided.

3. Will the Project be awarded for delivery of equipment in 2019?

Installation, especially PIP Rubber, may be subject to weather conditions- will that be taken into consideration or is there an expected time table?

4. Are there local or in-Town facilities for disposal of equipment or can equipment/materials be stockpiled on site for disposal offsite by DPW at Town facility (this could be a Project cost saver allowing more money to invest into new play equipment).

5. Is there a COLOR SCHEME preference for each site that we can include with our 3D color renderings RFP submittals?

6. Will the Town receive/ offload and store the equipment prior to installation?

7. The RFP suggests "Spring Rocker" features- please note the Consumer Product Safety Commission does not recommend Spring/Coil Riders for

Public Playground areas due to high maintenance/vandalism. They are only recommended for supervised 2-5 environments (Pre-Schools, Day Care

etc.)

Answers:

- 1. No directional dimensions for each playground/site are available, a site visit would be required to get these directional dimensions.
- 2. There are no meeting notes for publication
- 3. The project will be awarded for delivery of equipment in 2019 and weather conditions will be considered.
- 4. Dumpsters will be provided by the City of Rochester for disposal of the old equipment
- 5. There is no color scheme
- 6. Yes an outdoor area will be provided for storage of the new equipment. The location will be at the DPW facility located at 45 Old Dover Road
