SPECIFICATIONS

SECTION 4.00 – MEASUREMENT & PAYMENT

- 1. DELETE Bid Form and replace with revised Bid Form provided as an Attachment to this Addendum. Per revised Bid Form, unit of measure for Item 6b – On-Site Contaminated Groundwater Treatment and Discharge to be per GALLON based on totalizer flow readings using a flow meter approved by the Engineer.

BIDDER'S QUESTIONS

- Q.14 Item 6b - On-site Contaminated Groundwater Disposal includes the cost of treating petroleum contaminated groundwater on-site and then discharging of treated water to a permitted discharge location approved by the Engineer. Measurement shall be by the gallon based upon flow totalizer readings using a flow meter approved by the Engineer. However on the Bid Form, Item 6B is shown to be paid as a Lump Sum item. Please advise on which Unit this will be paid for.
- A.14 Payment shall be per Gallon. See specification edit (Section 4.00 – Measurement & Payment) this addendum.

In compliance with your Advertisement for Bids, Bidder hereby proposes to perform all Work for the SOIL EXCAVATION AND DISPOSAL at THE FORMER KANE GONIC BRICKYARD SITE located at 58 Pickering Road in Rochester, New Hampshire in strict accordance with the Contract Documents, within the time set forth therein, and at the prices stated below.

By submission of this Bid, each Bidder certifies, and in the case of a joint Bid each party thereto certifies as to their own organization, that this Bid has been arrived at independently, without consultation, communication, or agreement as to any matter relating to the Bid with any other Bidder or with any competitor.

Bidder acknowledges receipt of the following Addendum:

The Bidder declares as follows:

1. The only parties interested in the Bid as Principals are named herein;
2. This Bid is made without collusion with any person, firm, or corporation;
3. No officer, agent, or employee of the Owner or Engineer is directly or indirectly interested in this Bid;
4. He understands the difficulties attendant upon execution of the Work, and the accuracy of all estimated quantities stated in this Bid, and they have carefully examined the proposed Agreement, the Plans and Specifications and other Contract Documents therein referred to and knows and understands the terms and provisions thereof;

BID (CONTINUED)

5. He understands that the quantities of Work tabulated in this Bid or indicated in the Specifications are only approximate and are subject to increase or decrease as deemed necessary by the Engineer.

The undersigned further understands and agrees that they are to furnish and provide for the respective item price Bid all the necessary material, machinery, implements, tools, labor, services, and other items of whatever nature, and to do and perform all the work necessary under the aforesaid conditions, to complete the above-mentioned Work in accordance with the Contract Documents.

Instructions for Completion of the Bid

1. The Bidder must bid on each item.
2. The Bid shall include all applicable taxes and fees.
3. The Bid must be completed in ink or typewritten.
4. The Bidder must multiply the unit price by the estimated quantity to obtain the Item Total.
5. In the event that the item total does not equal the unit price multiplied by the estimated quantity, the unit price bid shall be used to correct the item total. The corrected item total shall then be used to determine the Total Bid Price.

Should the Bidder fail to fulfill any of their agreements as hereinabove set forth, the Owner shall have the right to retain as liquidated damages the amount of the bid security which shall become the Owner's property.

The Bidder, by submittal of this Bid, agrees with the Owner that the amount of the Bid security deposited with this Bid fairly and reasonably represents the amount of damages the Owner will suffer due to failure of the Bidder to fulfill their agreements as above provided.
