The appellant was not present for the meeting. The appeal request a water and sewer abatement based on the Water & Sewer Adjustment Policy. The owner stated he was unaware of it and he had an outdoor spigot leaking.

Mr. Barnes made a motion to abate 38 units of water at \$5.55 for a total water abatement of \$210.90 and 75 units of sewer at \$6.75 for a total of \$506.25 on the October 2019 invoice. The motion was for a total abatement of \$717.15 plus all applicable interest charges. The motion was seconded by Mr. Johnson. The motion passed unanimously.

4.3 24 Charles St.- Nellie Bentz

The appellant was not present for the meeting. The appeal is for sewer only. The owner stated the water heater was leaking. A new water heater was installed by plumber and receipts were included in the packet submitted.

Mr. Barnes made a motion to abate 14 units of sewer at \$6.75 for a total of \$94.50 on the December 2019 invoice. The motion was for a total abatement of \$94.50 plus all applicable interest charges. The motion was seconded by Mr. Johnson. The motion passed unanimously.
